



## Patrwm Maneg Gof Twiddle Muff Pattern

### Materials

Needles : 6.00 mm. ( no 4)

Odd balls of double knitting or chunky wool

Buttons, ribbons, lace, anything that can be 'twiddled' but will not break or have sharp edges

### Directions

#### Cuff

1. Cast on 40 sts using 2 strands of double knitting or 1 strand of chunky wool
2. Work in stocking stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row ) for 11ins

#### Muff body

3. Continue with stocking stitch using oddments of various textures of wool  
e.g. mohair, ribbon, chenille, chunky, etc until work measures 23 ins
4. Cast off.
5. Decorate the muff body with beads, flowers, buttons, lace, ribbon, etc  
Make sure each item is securely attached. If using ribbon, stitch it in place on the wrong side of the muff and pull the ribbon through to the right side before tying into a bow.  
Double check that everything cannot be pulled off.
6. Join the long sides together with pearl side facing you.
7. Turn the muff inside out.
8. Push cuff up inside the muff body and sew together the two short ends.  
There will be ' twiddles' on the inside and outside of the muff.
